This is a Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) to glycerolize and deglycerolize human red cells in the 800 ml primary Polyvinylchloride (PVC) plastic collection bag system The glycerolized red cells are concentrated and the supernatant glycerol removed prior to freezing The glycerolized red cells are washed in the Haemonetics Blood Processor 115

NATIONAL STANDARDS FOR BLOOD TRANSFUSION SERVICE ...

Blood collection: A procedure whereby a single donation of blood is collected in an anticoagulant solution Blood product: Any therapeutic substance derived from human blood, including whole blood, blood components and plasma derived products Calibrate: To set measurement of equipment against a known standard

Specimen Collection Procedures and Policies

Use a large enough needle to permit adequate flow of blood Avoid drawing blood from a vein associated with a hematoma If patient has had a mastectomy, do not draw blood from that side Always use standard precautions when drawing or handling blood specimens and ...
