position on the guitar Chord symbols have been simplified, especially on dominant chords As you play through the etudes, try to keep track of which chord tones are played over each chord type These solos should be played at a relatively slow tempo - quarter note = 80 to 140

(Piano) Improvisation Technique

Accompaniment is based on chords and scales Chords are based on scales I consider the Blues like a key: for example Bb Blues or Bb minor Blues can be considered two kind of Major and Minor keys You always have to know in which key you are playing in each moment

Chords with tensions use the basic four-note chord as the foundation Young players may simply play the basic four-note chords until tensions are introduced to them • Ex: C9 is really a C7 with an added 9 Young musicians can simply play a C7 until tensions are introduced • Guide Tones are the 3rd and the 7th of any chord

ment playing chords and bass runs Paramount continued its experimentation with minimal stringed instrument accompaniment in August 1924, when Ma Rainey recorded two blues accompanied by a twelve-string guitarist, who played a continuous melodic line without much attempt to make the instrument answer the singer's voice

how to play the blues guitar scale in e minor secrets of the guitar By using a metronome start with quarter notes keep the metronome between 60 70 bpm all of these guitar chords are part of a common chord progression in blues music that progression is the 12 bar blues the accompaniment the first is the shuffle pattern played by boogie
