Critical thinking is a thinking skill that includes interpreting, analysing, and evaluating assumptions, values, ideas, hidden thoughts and arguments [1, 2] Critical thinking, when linked to the revised edition of Bloom's taxonomy, is the top cognitive process of analysing and evaluating [3] According to Ennis [4],
