Steps in a Guided Reading Lesson - Midway ISD

**Teachers should conduct guided reading groups daily Students below grade level must meet with teacher 5 days a week Students on grade level need to meet with the teacher at least 3 to 4 times a week Students above grade level need to meet with the teacher at least 2 to 3 times a week

Guided Reading and Second-Language Learners

Teachers provide a purpose for reading the portion of the text, teach strategies for reading unknown words, and comprehension strategies The short (15-20 minute) lesson has a daily focus and makes use of every moment as the group reads a selection with the guidance of the teacher Teachers often tell me that guided reading is a repeat of the
