bilateral Hematomas should be drained as soon as possible If they are left untreated, fibrin formation can occur, leading to fibrosis, contraction and thickening, potentially leaving the ear with a deformed cauliflower-like appearance 2 If treatment is delayed, surgical intervention may be more difficult and scars will be more like-ly to form
