Monarch Migration and Breeding In The Southwest

While most migrating monarchs fly to California coastal sites or to the Monarch Butterfly Biosphere Reserve in Mexico, in most years several hundred monarchs instead spend the winter in the lower deserts of California and Arizona at familiar sites and in city backyards To date no overwintering monarchs have been observed in New Mexico

In eastern North America, monarch butterflies (*Danaus plexippus*) undertake a remarkable migration every fall, traveling up to 3600 km to reach their overwintering grounds in central Mexico (1) Migrating monarchs use a time-compensated Sun compass to navigate (2, 3) It is not known,
