MRI Ordering Guidelines Exam Reason for Exam Contrast?

prior to exam Oral contrast in MRI; arrive 1 hour before scan time to drink Used to detect and characterize Crohn's disease, terminal ileitis, small bowel and colonic strictures, rule out abscess, phlegmon or fistula Lymphadenopathy assessment, tumor surveillance or tumor staging With IV Contrast and With oral contrast Pelvis
