PYD has gained momentum as an asset-based alternative to prevailing deficit models of adolescent development (R M Lerner et al, 2011) A primary assumption is that positive development is promoted across the life span when the ecological assets surrounding an individual are arranged well, by identity work, provide a sense of autonomy
