Ultrasound can confirm the presence and size of an aortic aneurysm¹³ It cannot exclude rupture However, ultrasound confirmation of an aortic aneurysm in a patient with abdominal/back pain or hypotension supports the clinical diagnosis of rAAA, and a well-visualised, normal aorta in a haemodynamically stable patient excludes rAAA Ultrasound

Background: Elective abdominal aortic aneurysm (AAA) surgery relies on balancing the risk of the intervention against the risk of the aneurysm causing death Although much is known about intervention at 55 cm, little is known about the fate of the patient unfit for elective surgery at this threshold

on Stent-Graft Techniques for Abdominal Aortic Aneurysm Repair (EUROSTAR) registry, showed that the ratio of aneurysm-related to unrelated death was about 50% in patients with AAA ≥ 65 cm compared with 28% in a smaller aneurysm group The mean preoperative AAA size of those that ruptured after EVAR is 65 cm in Lifeline registry [13]

Probability of rupture of an abdominal aortic aneurysm ...

The five thoracoabdominal aneurysm were not repaired Four patients are awaiting repair During this same 40-month period, two other patients, not known to have an abdominal aortic aneurysm, died of a ruptured abdominal aortic aneurysm after another operative procedure, at 21 days and 77 days All three ruptured

with abdominal aortic aneurysm (AAA) have significant concomitant coronary heart disease (CAD) (1) An AAA is usually asymptomatic until it ruptures The risk of rupture is proportional to the size Rupture risk exceeds 5-10% per year in aneurysms with a diameter of 55 mm or more (18) Ruptured aortic aneurysm (rAAA) is lethal in most cases
