Layout, Cutting, and Marking

in the sewing process Accurate marking throughout garment construction is extremely important This process begins with marking pattern symbols How and where you mark the garment will aid you in putting the garment together Marking should be done as soon as the garment sections have been cut and before the pattern pieces have been removed

The structural lines of a garment give it shape and help to form the silhouette Structural lines are made by sewing together the parts of a garment Seams and darts are structural lines because they shape the garment A garment can sometimes be cut in certain places to make a special seam This seam is still considered a structured line

Garment Minimum Upper Arm Ease Blouse 1" to 1½" Dress 1½" to 2" Unlined jacket 3" to 4" Lined jacket 3" to 4½" Coat 4" to 5½" Garment Minimum Back Ease Blouse, Dress ½" to 1" Jacket 1" Coat 1" to 2" Garment Minimum Bust Ease Blouse, Dress 2½" to 3" Unlined jacket 3" to 4"

Sewing Technique: Attaching Garment Fasteners

Sewing Technique: Attaching Garment Fasteners Hook and eyes and snaps are used in clothing construction as a fastener to close a garment There are several types of hooks and eyes and snaps each designed to server a particular purpose Snaps and hook and eyes are small but very strong when appropriately attached

the hem and garment, 1/8 to 1/4 inch (3 to 6 mm) from the hem edge, take a small stitch in the hem. Then move diagonally to the right to take the next stitch in the garment. Alternate stitching in this zigzag fashion. Keep stitches loose to keep the hem edge flexible. Tacks are hand-sewing stitches done during marking or construction.

APPAREL - Jo-Ann Stores

- Bodkin- a sewing tool that acts like tweezers to draw elastic, cording and other materials through tubing and casings. Can also be used to insert elastic into a waistband or sleeve during garment construction.
- Chalk wheel or tailor's chalk- temporary marking to transfer quilting designs, seam allowances,
