Courtship violence is the use of physical aggression, sexual aggression, and/or sexual coercion in dating relationships Lifetime prevalence rates for physical aggression for college students run from 17% to 66%, with approximately one-third of men and 40% of women acknowledging their own use of physical aggression (Sugarman and Hotaling 1989)

The prevalence of sexual coercion by men has been widely researched. Because the current study investigated the etiology of sexual coercion by women as well as men, this review will focus on studies of prevalence that present rates for both men and women in dating relationships. Sexual violence

Sexual violence encompasses acts that range from verbal harassment to forced penetration, and an array of types of coercion, from social pressure and intimidation to physical force. Sexual violence (Box 1) includes, but is not limited to: n rape within marriage or dating relationships; n rape by strangers or acquaintances;
