How to teach Grammar

expectations that teaching will be grammar-focused may stem from frustration experienced at trying to pick up a second language in a non-classroom

setting, such as through self-study, or through immersion in the target language culture

Teachers' theories in grammar teaching

grammar teaching instructional contexts which are ill-defined In ELT, grammar teaching clearly constitutes such an ill-defined domain: the role of formal instruction itself has been a perennial area of debate, and more than 20 years of research have failed to yield firm guidelines for grammar
