### **Welfare Reform: A Continued Failure?**

welfare reform bill since the passage of the Social Security Act in the 1930s The bill was designed to revise the AFDC, which emphasized education, child support, and job training to avoid governmental dependency The Family Support Act proved to be a failure, so once again welfare reform was on the agenda in 1993 (Bane & Ellwood, 1994)
